

Golfe-Juan has two ports: the Old Port, which is a public port, managed by the Chamber of Commerce and that deals with both the fishing industry and boating for pleasure, and the Port Camille Rayon, the most recent boating port of the Côte d'Azur and which was developed in 1989.

Enjoy two very different atmospheres: from the traditional port, bustling with fishing activities, to the pleasures of the Port Camille Rayon and its magnificent yachts. On the promenades of the ports there are many shops and terraces to stop and enjoy. It is a real paradise for strollers and boating enthusiasts alike!

We recommend:

a walk to the end of the jetties... In January and February, the time of the mistral winds, exceptional views can be enjoyed from here: hills dotted with mimosas and the snow-capped mountains of the Mercantour that stand out against the sea blue sky. Here the 'Alpes-Maritimes' certainly live up to their namesake.

SOME NAUTICAL FACTS

La Fourmigue is the name given to the green light that shines from the lighthouse in the middle of Golfe-Juan bay to warn ships of a dangerous coral reef. This area is one of the most heavily populated with fish (sargo bream, ocean bream, groupers).

The lighthouse is located on top of the Maure hill and is remarkable in that it is the highest lighthouse in Europe at 170.50 metres above sea level.

Note:

Many regattas are organised throughout the year by the sailing club. At the beginning of July the festival of Saint-Pierre and the Sea takes place with a ceremony on the water, a flotilla of pointer boats, concert, procession, and much more.



FISHING

Professional fishing in Golfe-Juan is typically carried out using traditional methods. The majority of the boats are 'pointers' that are equipped with a wheel net tow. Each net is designed for a particular type of catch: a mesh net for catching rock-fish and drift nets to catch migrating fish and long lines. A few of the names of fish that you will see during the season on the fishermen's boats in the Old Port are: conger eels, gilt-head bream, red sea breams, red mullet, sargo breams, sea bass, John Dory, not forgetting sea urchins and fry.
